## **Call for Papers - Human Factors in Enviromatics**

Environmental Informatics (or Enviromatics) is a maturing subject with interdisciplinary roots. The application of information and communication technology (ICT) to the environment is emerging as one of great importance as the health of our planet gains priority on research agendas. Modelling is an important aspect of enviromatics, but it is not the only one. Ultimately, environmental information must be put into people's hands so that they can make decisions. Answering the question of how best to involve stakeholders so that they can access the information they need and put it to use in a satisfying manner is a topic of ongoing research. Contributions are sought for a special session of ISESS on human factors in enviromatics, to be held in Prague, May 22-27, 2007. Topics include, but are not limited to: usability analyses, decision psychology, task analyses, human-computer interface design, and human performance evaluation.

Acceptance will be based on the abstracts and authors will be informed by December 22, 2006. Final versions of accepted papers AND registration of one author per accepted paper must be submitted before February 25, 2007. These papers will included in a pre-conference publication, tentatively under an IFIP ISBN.
